Reflection on the Gloria Patri:

"The doxology, Glory be to the Father which, in conformity with the orientation common to Christian piety, concludes the prayer of the Rosary with the glorifying of God who is one and three, from whom, through whom and in whom all things have their being" (cf Rom 11:36). (*Marialis Cultus*, No. 49)
